HOUSE BILL 2053

AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 28, CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE 6, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 28-3322; RELATING TO DRIVING PRIVILEGES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:
2 Section 1. Title 28, chapter 8, article 6, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 28-3322, to read:
4 28-3322. Suspension of license for persons eighteen, nineteen
5 and twenty years of age; definition
6 A. IN ADDITION TO THE GROUNDS FOR MANDATORY REVOCATION PROVIDED FOR IN
7 CHAPTERS 3, 4 AND 5 OF THIS TITLE, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IMMEDIATELY SUSPEND
8 THE DRIVER LICENSE OR PRIVILEGE TO DRIVE OR REFUSE TO ISSUE A DRIVER LICENSE
9 OR PRIVILEGE TO DRIVE OF A PERSON WHO COMMITS A VIOLATION OF SECTION 4-244,
10 PARAGRAPH 33 WHILE THE PERSON IS EIGHTEEN, NINETEEN OR TWENTY YEARS OF AGE ON
11 RECEIPT OF THE RECORD OF THE PERSON'S CONVICTION FOR A VIOLATION OF SECTION
12 4-244, PARAGRAPH 33 FOR A PERIOD OF TWO YEARS.
13 B. IF ORDERED BY THE COURT, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL RESTRICT THE PERSON'S
14 PRIVILEGE TO DRIVE BETWEEN THE PERSON'S HOME, SCHOOL AND PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT
15 DURING SPECIFIED PERIODS OF TIME ACCORDING TO THE PERSON'S SCHOOL AND
16 EMPLOYMENT SCHEDULE.
17 C. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "CONVICTION" MEANS A FINAL
18 CONVICTION OR JUDGMENT, INCLUDING AN ORDER OF THE JUVENILE COURT FINDING THAT
19 A JUVENILE VIOLATED ANY PROVISION OF THIS TITLE OR COMMITTED A DELINQUENT ACT
20 THAT IF COMMITTED BY AN ADULT WOULD CONSTITUTE A CRIMINAL OFFENSE.
