# HOUSE BILL 2205

AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF ARIZONA PARTNERSHIP FOR THE NEW ECONOMY INITIATIVES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; purpose; exemption

3 A. The sum of \$1,500,000 is appropriated from the state general fund  
4 in each of fiscal years 2001-2002 and 2002-2003 to the department of commerce  
5 for implementation of initiatives associated with the Arizona partnership for  
6 the new economy. The department shall use monies for initiatives relating to  
7 telecommunications infrastructure development, electronic government, high  
8 technology industry cluster business development and coordination, electronic  
9 learning, entrepreneurial business assistance and new economy marketing  
10 development.

11 B. The appropriations made in subsection A of this section are exempt  
12 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to  
13 lapsing of appropriations, except that monies remaining unexpended and  
14 unencumbered on June 30, 2003 revert to the state general fund.
