MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR IMMUNIZATION
PROGRAMS.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; purpose; exemption

3 A. The sum of \$500,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in
4 each of the fiscal years 2001-2002 and 2002-2003 to the department of health
5 services, \$425,000 for community immunization programs at community health
6 centers as determined by section 330 of the federal public health service act
7 and \$75,000 to maintain a partnership with the private health care sector to
8 improve the delivery of immunizations in this state and to maintain public
9 awareness of the need to fully immunize citizens against vaccine preventable
10 diseases.

11 B. The appropriations made in subsection A of this section are exempt
12 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
13 lapsing of appropriations.
