MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC SECURITY FOR NAVAJO  
CAPITAL PROJECTS AT KAYENTA.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:  
2 Section 1. Appropriation; purpose; exemption  
3 A. The sum of \$2,796,763 is appropriated from the state general fund  
4 in fiscal year 2001-2002 to the department of economic security for  
5 distribution to the Navajo Nation for the following capital projects:  
6 1. Kayenta chapter headstart building-\$1,343,321.  
7 2. Kayenta unified school district number 27 access road, dike  
8 relocation and wash crossing-\$928,642.  
9 3. Kayenta chapter senior citizens center-\$524,800.  
10 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt  
11 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to  
12 lapsing of appropriations.
