AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF TOURISM FOR RENOVATION OF THE FORMER  
PHOENIX INDIAN SCHOOL FOR A NATIVE AMERICAN CULTURAL AND TOURISM CENTER.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; purpose; exemption

3 A. The sum of \$500,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in  
4 fiscal year 2001-2002 to the office of tourism for renovation and capital  
5 improvements to the former Phoenix Indian School to establish a Native  
6 American cultural and tourism center. The office of tourism may use up to  
7 ten per cent of the appropriated monies for oversight and administrative  
8 costs.

9 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt  
10 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to  
11 lapsing of appropriations.
