AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR RURAL
AMBULANCES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; purpose; exemption

3 A. Subject to availability of monies in the fund, the sum of
4 \$1,500,000 is appropriated from the emergency medical services operating fund
5 established by section 36-2218, Arizona Revised Statutes, in fiscal year
6 2001-2002 to the department of health services for distribution to rural
7 areas to provide ambulances, as determined by the director of the department
8 after consultation with the emergency medical services council.

9 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
10 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
11 lapsing of appropriations.
