# SENATE BILL 1201

AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR RURAL  
AMBULANCES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriations; purpose

3 A. Subject to availability of monies in the fund, the sum of  
4 \$1,500,000 is appropriated from the emergency medical services operating fund  
5 established by section 36-2218, Arizona Revised Statutes, in fiscal year  
6 2001-2002 to the department of health services for distribution to rural  
7 areas to improve emergency medical services, as determined by the director of  
8 the department after consultation with the emergency medical services  
9 council.

10 B. Subject to availability of monies in the fund, the sum of \$200,000  
11 is appropriated from the emergency medical services operating fund  
12 established by section 36-2218, Arizona Revised Statutes, in each of fiscal  
13 years 2001-2002 and 2002-2003 to the department of health services for  
14 distribution to rural areas for increased costs associated with providing  
15 ambulance services.
