FISCAL ANALYSIS

Description

This bill amends the statutes governing the Structural Pest Control Commission (SPCC) by defining a series of fees currently collected by the agency. As amended, the bill does not create any new fees, nor does it increase any fees, collected by the SPCC.

Estimated Impact

The JLBC Staff estimates no General Fund impact as a result of this bill. Of these fees, 90% are deposited into the Structural Pest Control Commission Fund and 10% are deposited into the General Fund. Since the bill defines fees currently collected by the SPCC, we also estimate that there will be no fiscal impact to the Structural Pest Control Commission Fund.

Local Government Impact

None.

Amendments

As introduced, the bill defines fees currently collected by the SPCC, as well as increasing certain fees charged by the agency. The House Committee on Commerce and Economic Development amended the bill by removing the proposed fee increases, as well as removing a Proposition 108 clause. The Commerce and Economic Development Committee's amendment was adopted in the Committee of the Whole.
