AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 8, CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 8-817; RELATING TO CHILDREN.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 8, chapter 10, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 8-817, to read:

4 8-817. Training requirements

5 A. AT THE TIME OF LICENSING, THE LICENSING AGENCY MUST PROVIDE FOSTER
6 PARENTS AND CHILD CARE PROVIDERS WITH INFORMATION AND TRAINING REGARDING
7 OFFICIAL PROTECTIVE SERVICES POLICIES.

8 B. BEFORE BEING ASSIGNED TO A CASE, EACH AGENCY EMPLOYEE AND
9 CONTRACTED WORKER ARE REQUIRED TO BE TRAINED ON ALL ASPECTS OF THE OFFICIAL
10 PROTECTIVE SERVICES POLICIES.
