# SENATE BILL 1005

AN ACT

AMENDING SECTION 20-1368, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Section 20-1368, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to  
3 read:

4 20-1368. Intoxicants and narcotics; exception

5 A. There may be a provision as follows: "Intoxicants and  
6 narcotics: The insurer shall not be liable for any loss sustained or  
7 contracted in consequence of the insured's being intoxicated or under the  
8 influence of any narcotic unless administered on the advice of a physician."

9 B. AN INSURER SHALL NOT USE THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION A OF THIS  
10 SECTION WITH RESPECT TO A DISABILITY POLICY.

11 C. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, DISABILITY POLICY DOES NOT  
12 INCLUDE A LONG-TERM CARE INSURANCE POLICY AS DEFINED IN SECTION 20-1691 OR  
13 LIMITED BENEFIT COVERAGE AS DEFINED IN SECTION 20-1137, EXCEPT FOR AN  
14 ACCIDENT ONLY POLICY OR A FIXED OR HOSPITAL INDEMNITY POLICY.
