REPEALING SECTION 41-3002.20, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; AMENDING TITLE 41, CHAPTER 27, ARTICLE 2, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 41-3007.10; RELATING TO THE AUTOMOBILE THEFT AUTHORITY.

2 Section 1. Repeal
3 Section 41-3002.20, Arizona Revised Statutes, is repealed.
4 Sec. 2. Title 41, chapter 27, article 2, Arizona Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by adding section 41-3007.10, to read:
6 41-3007.10. Automobile theft authority; termination July 1,

8 A. THE AUTOMOBILE THEFT AUTHORITY TERMINATES ON JULY 1, 2007.
9 B. TITLE 41, CHAPTER 31 IS REPEALED ON JANUARY 1, 2008.
10 Sec. 3. Purpose
11 The purpose of the automobile theft authority is to provide assistance
12 to law enforcement with funding and programs to reduce the incidence of
13 automobile theft.
14 Sec. 4. Retroactivity
15 Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective retroactively to January 1,
16 2002.
