1 Be it resolved by the Senate of the State of Arizona, the House of
2 Representatives concurring:
3 1. Article XI, section 3, Constitution of Arizona, is proposed to be
4 amended as follows if approved by the voters and on proclamation of the
5 Governor:
6 3. State board of education; composition; powers and
7 duties; compensation
8 Section 3. The state board of education shall be composed
9 of the following members: the superintendent of public
10 instruction, the president of a state university or a state
11 college, ~~three~~ FOUR lay members, ~~a member of the state junior~~
12 ~~college board~~ A PRESIDENT OR CHANCELLOR OF A COMMUNITY COLLEGE
13 DISTRICT, A PERSON WHO IS AN OWNER OR ADMINISTRATOR OF A CHARTER
14 SCHOOL, a superintendent of a high school district, a classroom
15 teacher and a county school superintendent. Each member, other
16 than the superintendent of public instruction, ~~to~~ SHALL be
17 appointed by the governor with the consent of the senate in the
18 manner prescribed by law. The powers, duties, compensation and
19 expenses, and the terms of office, of the board shall be such as
20 may be prescribed by law.
21 2. The Secretary of State shall submit this proposition to the voters
22 at the next general election as provided by article XXI, Constitution of
23 Arizona.
