AN ACT

AMENDING TITLE 15, CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 1, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES, BY ADDING SECTION 15-103; RELATING TO EDUCATION.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Title 15, chapter 1, article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes,
3 is amended by adding section 15-103, to read:

4 15-103. No child left behind act; optional participation

5 A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER SCHOOL MAY NOTIFY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF
6 PUBLIC INSTRUCTION IN WRITING AT ANY TIME THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR CHARTER
7 SCHOOL WILL NOT BE PARTICIPATING IN OR BE SUBJECT TO THE NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND
8 ACT OF 2001 (P.L. 107-110).
